The LifePoint Syringe Access service is available through Portage County Health and Human Services - Division of Public Health. The program is in partnership with Vivent Health (formerly known as the AIDS Resource Center of Wisconsin). The purpose of LifePoint is to reduce the transmission of HIV and Hepatitis C and other potential harms associated with different methods of substance use. LifePoint seeks to reduce overdoses while maintaining the overall health of someone who uses substances.
